

ORDINANCE NO. 377-R
OF THE PORT OF PORTLAND

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING UNCONCEALED FIREARMS AT PORTLAND
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 348

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PORT OF PORTLAND:

SECTION 1. Section 3.8 of Ordinance 348 is hereby amended to add a new subsection (4), the entire section to then read as follows:

3.8 No person shall carry or possess a firearm or destructive device on the airport except:

(1) Firearms in a motor vehicle while the motor vehicle is upon the airport streets and roads, or in the motor vehicle parking and storage area;

(2) Firearms enclosed in a container for shipment by air in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration Regulations;

(3) Firearms carried by peace officers, government employees, or members of the Armed Forces of the United States;

(4) Unconcealed firearms carried by persons employed by armored car companies under a permit issued by the Port's Chief of Police, or his designee, to service banking and other tenants at the Airport, which permission shall be consistent with the terms of the Port's most current Airport Security Plan, as that may be approved by the Federal Aviation Administration.

ADOPTED THIS 17th DAY OF Feb., 1996, being the date of the second reading before the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Portland.
